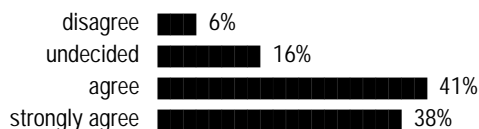

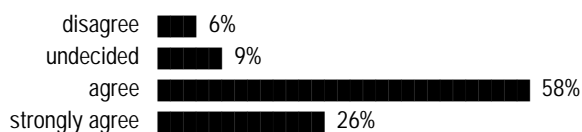

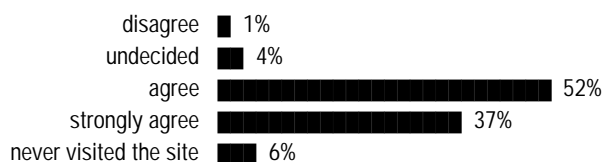

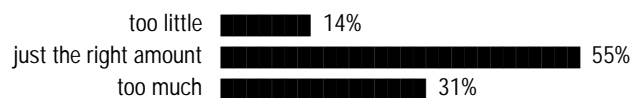

12a. How much food was supplied to you for breakfast?



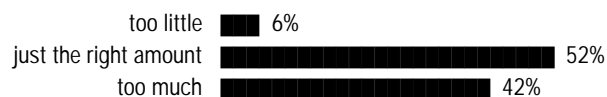

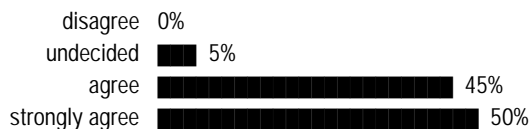

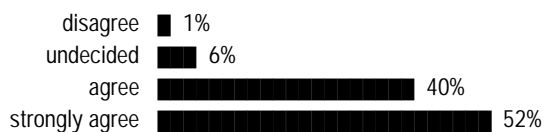

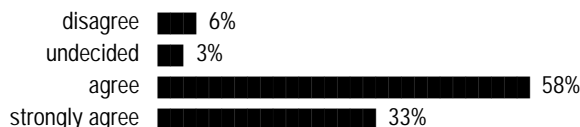

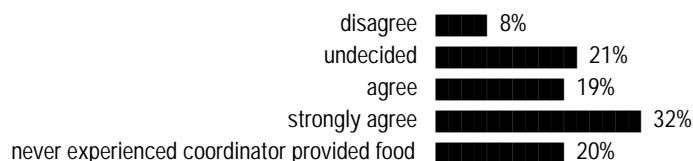

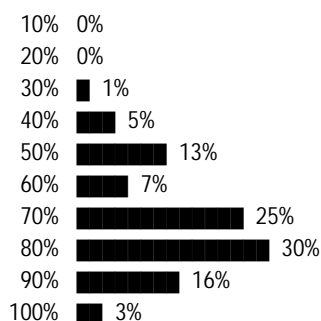

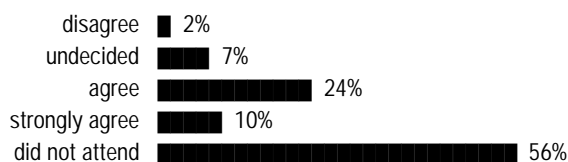
